The election of the Ringgold Fire District is Tuesday, December 11, 2018 from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM at The Ringgold Fire Co. #1 building at 12 Lake Street Pulaski, New York 13142.

Petition for appearing on the ballot

Person's interested in being included on the ballot as a candidate for one (1) five-year position as fire commissioner for the Ringgold Fire District are required to petition signatures of twenty-five (25) residents of the district. The official petitions are available from the secretary by calling 315-529-1760 and leaving a message. The petition must be returned to the secretary no later than 5:00 PM on Wednesday, November 21, 2018 to appear on the December 11, 2018 ballot.

Fire District Voter's Boundaries

For this election it was determined with the latest map available (1989) that the Ringgold Fire District will include those living within the Town of Richland borders except for: residents on Orton Road; the residents of Canning Factory Road east from the intersection of Canning Factory Road and Springbrook Road and Club Drive and the north side of Minot Drive to the town line. These areas will be protected by the Richland Fire Department in the hamlet of Richland.

Qualifications to vote in this election

The qualifications for voting in this election are: to be a citizen of the United States; a resident of the Town of Richland Ringgold Fire Co. #1 in Oswego County, New York for a minimum of thirty (30) days prior to the election; must be eighteen (18) years of age on the day of the election; and must have registered to vote with the Board of Elections of Oswego County by the qualified date for said election.
